Our Parent Aides and Bachelor's Level workers are available to testify and can be accompanied by a Master's Level Clinician as a Supervisor if needed. Our Master's Level Clinicians are considered Expert Witnesses.

We also provide other reimbursable services, including hospital and hotel sittings and long distance transportation. If there is a need for services, we will do anything we can to fill that need!

Assessment Services

ProFamily has been setting a standard of excellence for CCFA Assessments in the North Georgia region. Our clinicians are thorough, timely, and dedicated to excellence as they prepare recommendations and strategies for families in crisis. Upon completion, CCFAs are submitted both on paper and electronically.

Our Master's Level Clinicians are trained in administering Alcohol and Drug Assessments and Anger Management Assessments for both adolescents and adults. The clinician will evaluate the individual and make recommendations regarding treatment.

Whether a Home Evaluation is court-ordered or needed for evidentiary support in a custody hearing, ProFamily can meet your need!

We understand that time is of the essence in these situations, so ProFamily makes completing the Home Evaluations in a timely manner a top priority. In fact, we guarantee that the Home Evaluation will be completed within a two week time period!

ProFamily also provides IMPACT training for those interested in becoming foster parents.

Our qualified family service consultants, bachelor's level, and master's level clinicians are experienced in providing the highest level of confidential care in every circumstance, including bilingual workers to serve the growing population of Hispanics in the North Georgia area.

We offer both Family Preservation (formerly CPS) and Placement services, as well as a variety of assessment services.

Our Family Preservation services include Early Intervention, Parent Aide, and Homestead counseling services.



The Placement Services we provide include In Home Intensive Counseling, In Home Case Management, Crisis Intervention, Court Appearance and Testimony, and other reimbursable services, such as hotel and hospital sittings.

ProFamily is a certified provider of CCFAs, Anger Management Assessments, Alcohol and Drug Assessments, and Independent Living Assessments, as well as home evaluations, home studies, and IMPACT classes.

Family Preservation (CPS) Services

Early Intervention services are integral in helping families before formal DFCS involvement is necessary. Our Family Service Consultants are trained and experienced in providing resources and education to parents and families in order to keep a formal DFCS case from being opened.

We also offer Parent Aide services, including the following areas of specialization:

- * Budget Education

- * Behavior Management
- * Alcohol & Substance Abuse Education
- * Anger Management Education
- * Tutoring



Many of our Family Service Consultants have specialized training in working with children with behavioral disorders and learning and developmental disabilities. If a referral of a sensitive nature is needed, we will make every effort to fully understand the circumstances before assigning a Family Service Consultant.

When a Family Preservation case requires counseling of any kind, we have Master's Level Clinicians, who are available for Homestead Services.

ProFamily counselors have training in various types of specific therapy, including Marriage and Family therapy, Play therapy, Grief therapy, and Substance Abuse therapy. We make every effort to assign the therapist who is best suited for each referral we receive.

Placement Services

In Home Intensive Counseling is provided by our Master's Level Clinicians and can include work with the parents and/or children in Foster Placement.

In Home Case Management is provided by Bachelor's level or Family Service Consultants, depending on the nature of the referral and its severity. These services can include any of the services offered under Family Preservation, whether the need is for a child in a group home or Foster Placement, or for a parent seeking reunification. Often, this includes supervised visitation services, which may be conducted in ProFamily's Private Visitation Room.

Crisis Intervention services are provided when a child in care is in need of behavior management or is in danger of disrupting his/her placement. Most often, these services are provided by a Master's Level Clinician and are contacted within two hours of referral.
